## ► Rethink your drink (in one visit to the wine shop)

**Chardonnay is the little black dress of wine—easy, beloved...and, well, a little predictable. JENNIFER SIMONETTI-BRYAN, instructor for the DVD course *The Everyday Guide to Wine*, upgrades what's in your glass.**

► **IF YOU LOVE:** Australian Chardonnays, like Yellow Tail...

**TRY:** A Chenin Blanc from South Africa. It has similar tropical notes.

► **IF YOU LOVE:** California Chardonnays, like Charles Shaw...

**TRY:** Viognier, a full-bodied varietal with lots of fruit, floral aromas, and buttery hints.

► **IF YOU LOVE:** White Burgundies made with chardonnay grapes, like Chablis...

**TRY:** Muscadet, from the Loire Valley. Like the white Burgundies, it's crisp, refreshing, and goes well with seafood.
